

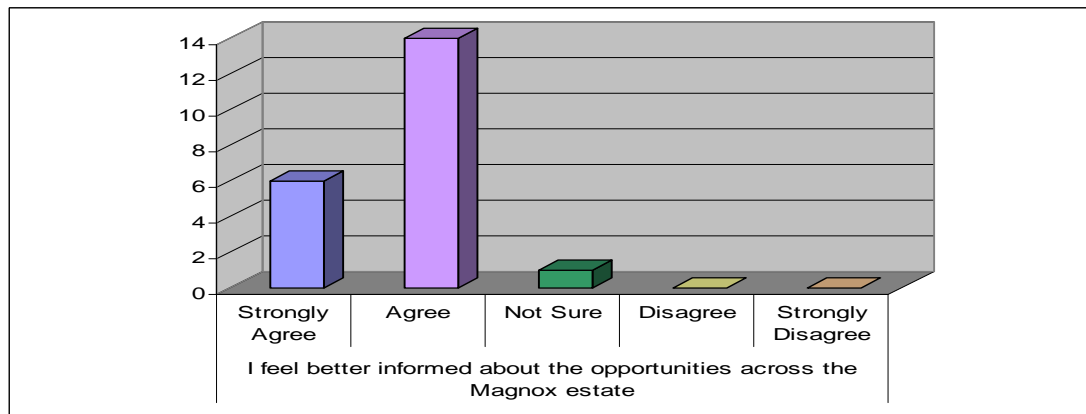
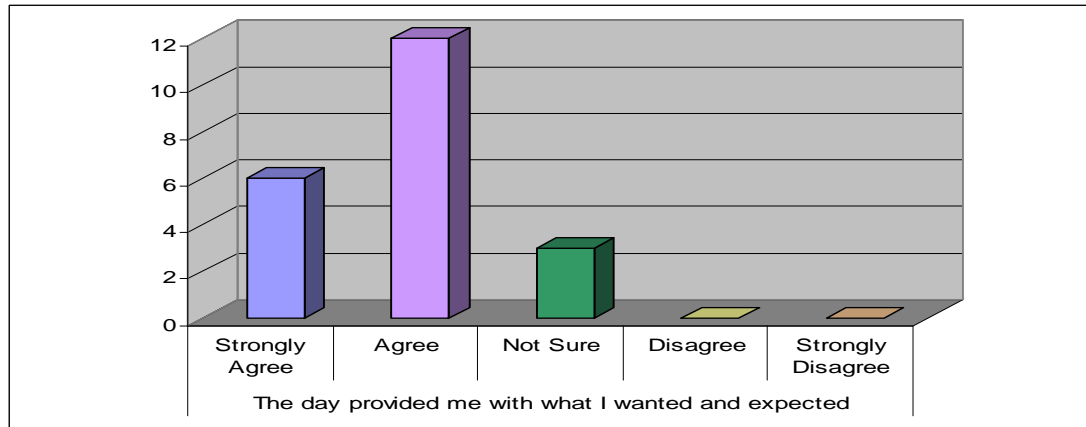

- Less on your supply chain improvement plan.

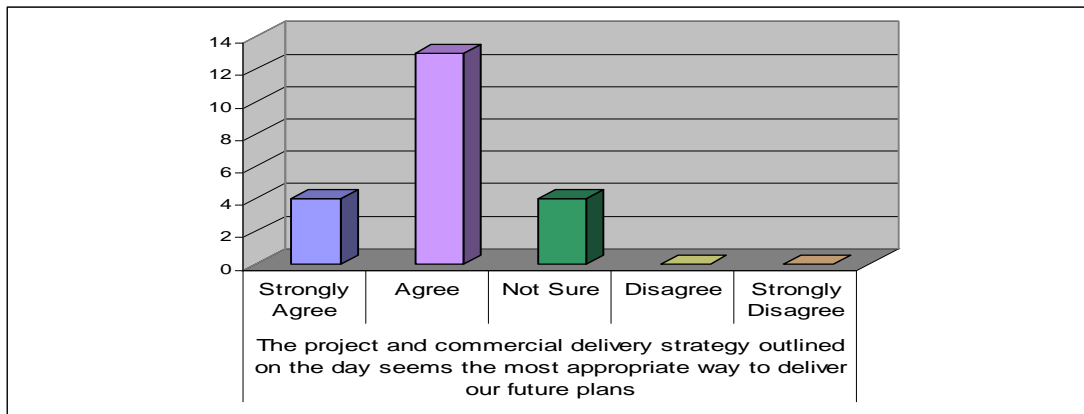
Common themes

- More involvement with the supply chain at an earlier stage.
- Longer term commitments.
- Invite suppliers to participate in presentations.
- Long term commitment with framework agreements to enable continuity of work.
- Keep up these events on a 6-8 month basis, they are a great step forward for engaging and communicating with the supply chain.

Messages for the NDA

- We need more firm data regarding NDA funding; otherwise our directors will have lost interest and put resources onto more definite work.

Project and Commercial Delivery



- Early engagement of the suppliers in an integrated way to work together during the optioneering phase.
- Provide a more functional specification to pull out best options from supply chain; provide data, research and preferences to help guide tenderers but not constrain them.
- Ensure sufficient funds are available to progress optimum programme, including sourcing alternative/supplementary.

Supply chain improvement plan (see also feedback received on the day)

- Identify a couple of Pathfinder projects to implement some of the workshop, feedback and report back on progress at the next event.
- Making the improvement plan to be a collective supplier/Magnox plan.
- Overwhelming interest in getting involved in helping developing and deliver items.
